JOB DESCRIPTION

Part-time position

Core Team Leader – Associate Pastor

General - as a staff team member of Wesleyan Chapel UMC, one is expected to be fully supportive of furthering the mission of the UMC “to make disciples of Jesus Christ for the transformation of the world” and of Wesleyan Chapel “to grow together in Christ to produce his fruit” and to support the core values of Vibrant Worship, Intentional Outreach, Nurturing Hospitality and Empowering Disciples (VINE). This ministry is primarily accountable under Vibrant Worship.

Worship - The Contemporary Music Director leads the 9:45 service in contemporary worship music each Sunday. This involves collaboration with the Associate Pastor primarily as well as Lead Pastor and Traditional Music Director and other church leadership in worship and in various church functions, activities, and planning.

Qualifications – The Contemporary Music Director:

- exhibits a passion for God and a Christ-like spirit.
- has a degree in music (preferred)
- has a minimum of one (1) year of experience in leading Christian music.
- is a proficient singer and has confidence in leading and directing a band.
- Preferably has proficiency in guitar and/or piano/keyboard.
- has the ability to create worship presentations. Experience using Powerpoint/ProPresenter preferred.
- has good people skills in communicating with others.
- is motivated and a self-starter who does not require close supervision to perform the assigned duties.
- is detail oriented, well organized and creative in seeking better ways to perform the assigned duties.
- works efficiently, both independently and in team situations.

Key Responsibilities and Duties

- Choosing worship music that corresponds with the Pastor’s messages and promotes passionate, meaningful worship.
- Recruiting, organizing, and scheduling musicians, sound technicians, and media technicians to serve on the contemporary worship team.
- Leading a weekly rehearsal.

- Finding/creating chord charts and arrangements of worship songs and other Christian music.
- Being an active participant in WCUMC Worship Planning and in the Vibrant Worship ministry.
- Collaborating with Church Staff and Servants for special worship functions including Christmas and Easter Cantatas, Blended Community Sunday Worship Services, Benefit Events/Concerts, Children's Musicals, and other church functions.
- Collaborating with church leaders in creating worship media presentations including song lyric displays, scrolling announcements, sermon slides, scripture, and other church media.
- Serving on church committees and projects related to the sanctuary, audio/visual media, and items designated by the Lead Pastor or Associate Pastor.
